



VOLUNTEER PROGRAM GUIDANCE

Requirements and Characteristics

Volunteers must exhibit the following characteristics:

- Willing to commit time and energy (at least 3 hours per week) for the length of at least 3 months.
- A highly regarded person who has demonstrated consistent efforts technically, interpersonally and organizationally in their career development or advancement.
- A good communicator who is willing to share knowledge, provide objective feedback, and help actively in activities of our students and volunteers.
- Capable of working in teams and with diverse groups.
- Knowledgeable about the AASuccess vision, mission, and its community relationships.
- Willing to participate in formal volunteer training to learn the tools of the program, and their role and responsibilities.
- Open to feedback and suggestions for improving his/her effectiveness as a volunteer
- Honors the principles of trust, respect, and confidentiality.

Volunteers, depending on skill sets and committed roles and responsibilities, can serve in any of the functional roles: volunteer task assignment based on life skills learning or civic projects, non-compete internship work, and skills mentoring/coaching work (certified and non-certified). The appointments within this program are subject to all requirements and conditions governing the enrolled volunteer per our policy and procedural manual.
